To empower Australian children who are sick, experiencing disadvantage or living with a disability to live, laugh and learn.


A Message from the **Motoring Team**



The Variety Postie Bike Dash saw 61 Dashers, including 19 newcomers, ride 1325 kilometres across northern New South Wales and southern Queensland. Along the route grants of \$36,000 were presented for equipment and tools across seven schools, supplying resources such as iPads, community gardens and tossball towers.



This year marked the 9th annual event, reaching new heights as we crossed state lines into Queensland.

Starting and ending the adventure in Armidale, a special thank you must go to the Armidale-based Black Widows Postie Bike Team who helped establish their town as home this year.

The Dashers raised \$212,000 across the 6-day ride – an extraordinary result! A highlight of the trip was the day we visited three schools as we travelled from Inverell over the Queensland border to Stanthorpe. The day started at Gum Flat Public School, a regional school just outside Inverell with just 19 students. This was followed by the opportunity to meet the wonderful communities at both Texas State School and Bonshaw Public School, where the Dashers presented grants and had a great time showing off their Postie Bikes to the kids.

Congratulations to David "Red Dog" Doherty, on Bike 990, who earned our Spirit of the Dash award for embodying everything that it means to be a Variety Dasher. A huge thank you and congratulations to our highest fundraisers, the Black Widows Team, as well as Tony Lewis on Bike 46 who was our highest fundraising individual.

This event would not be possible without our 22 OVs and COMMS team who brought their diverse range of skills to the event, ensuring that it ran smoothly. Thank you to our amazing sponsors First National Real Estate, Tamex Transport and Australia Post for being part of the Variety family, and to the Resqued Services team and Pivotel for their ongoing support.

along the route.


The 2023 Riders followed remote tracks through western New South Wales, exploring the Gammon and Flinders Ranges, Strzelecki Desert and Cameron Corner, whilst granting funds to PCYC Dubbo, Rankins Springs Public School and Wanaaring Public School along the way.

One of the most memorable days was our visit to Wanaaring Public School. It was a fantastic day, filled with lots of smiles and handball tournaments between the riders and the kids. The community at Wanaaring Public School were thrilled to receive over \$9,000 to rebuild their playground equipment.

A huge thank you and congratulations must go to our Spirit of the Ride winner, Nick Pope, on Bike 24 and our highest individual fundraiser Serge Crismale on Bike 63.

To the 22 OVs and our COMMS team who helped us out on the event – thank you for giving up your time, experience and professionalism to ensure the 2023 Variety Adventure Ride was a tremendous success.








Our 66 Adventurers saw enormous success with the Variety 4WD Adventure raising \$220,000.

Travelling from the Coffs Coast to Lamington National Park over six days, our Adventurers granted \$30,000 of equipment and resources to three organisations along the route: Emerge Toowoomba, Warwick Girl Guides and Redfins Swim Club.



A highlight from the trip was the presentation of a \$10,000 grant to Emerge Youth Toowoomba who provide emergency accommodation, mentorship, training, employment and social opportunities to help young people be their best selves. The grant paid for crisis kits for young people, which include simple things that we might take for granted - a pillow, linen, sleeping bag, a blanket, towel, toiletries, a food and clothing voucher and a bag to store it all in. The Variety 4WD Adventurers were lucky to meet Founder, Jen Shaw, and one of the children Emerge supports - there was not a dry eye in the room as we heard about the tough times she had been going through, unable to live at home.

Congratulations to Car 4660 - The Flying Scotsman, driven by Cheryl and Bill Randall, who won the prestigious Spirit of the Adventure for highlighting all that the Variety 4WD Adventure is about.

Thank you to the 10 OVs who lent their time and expertise to ensure the event ran smoothly - we could not have done it without you. We are grateful to Hare & Forbes for donating a replica Flatbed Felix and to Pickles for facilitating the auction.

The Variety NSW Bash was an enormous success, raising \$1.59 million for kids in need. Stopping at 16 regional towns, the Bashers travelled 2,160 kilometres visiting 12 schools along the way.

This year's Variety NSW Bash started with a 'bang' when the decision was made to move the starting line from Newcastle to Dubbo, allowing us to explore different areas across the state. 274 Bashers, 88 of whom were new, spent seven days travelling to the Victorian border and back again, granting \$80,000 of equipment and resources to 12 different schools. These ranged from a food van for hospitality training, a chicken coop and chicken run, a cubby house, a sandpit, a shade sail, netball and basketball towers, trikes, a 3D printer, podcast equipment, laptops, iPads, Lego, science apparatus and a library refurbishment.

The event ended with an unforgettable Variety Family Fun Day held at Newcastle Foreshore, where families celebrated the arrival of our colourful and wonderful characters in their Bash Cars.

Congratulations to Car 2760 - St Marys Rugby League Club who won the Spirit of the Bash award, as well as our highest fundraisers: Nostalgic NRL, our highest fundraising team, and Car 10 - Team Daracon, our highest fundraising car!

Travelling almost coast to coast, the Variety B to B Bash was an unforgettable event that raised \$1.58 million to help kids in need. The 11-day event travelled 6,000 kilometres, granting \$80,000 of equipment and resources to nine schools along the route.

The 2023 B to B Bash travelled an epic route from Bathurst, Australia's oasis for all things motoring, to the picturesque Batavia Coast in Western Australia. This year's event had 219 participants, 38 of which were new participants, travelling in 70 Bash cars through 21 regional towns. These Bashers not only helped kids in need, but injected tourism dollars into these small communities through the purchasing of meals and overnight accommodation.

One of the highlights of our coast-to-coast adventure was visiting Burke Ward Public School. There our Bashers granted over \$4,000 towards garden beds and equipment for the kids grow their own edible garden. These will give the schools the opportunity to not only provide Crunch and Sip to students who don't bring their own provisions, but also provide fruit and vegetables to families in the community who may be doing it tough.

A huge congratulations to Car 888 & 999: Team Star Wars who were the outright Winners of the 2023 B to B Bash! They were unanimously voted by their peers for always being ready to lend a hand, constantly entertaining the kids at school stops and epitomising what the Spirit of the Bash is all about. We also want to congratulate the Moree Showgirls, our highest individual fundraisers, and Team Toshiba, our highest corporate team of fundraisers. Thank you to our 34 OVs on the event and 4 COMMS, as well as Resqmed who were on the road, supporting our Bashers as they drove across the country.
