



The 2023 Variety Postie Bike Dash was our biggest and best Dash to date, with the 10th anniversary ride raising an enormous \$379,800. This is the largest amount the Dash has raised in the 10 years it has been running.

Our 117 Dashers, 27 of whom joined for the first time, rode 1,130 kilometres, starting in Goulburn, venturing to Ulladulla, tracking down to Merimbula, before heading inland to the Snowy Mountains and circling back to Goulburn. Over the course of our epic six-day ride, we granted seven schools and one community group a total of \$32,664 to fund vital equipment such as sensory items, decodable readers and sports equipment.

During the Dash, we announced our very first Hall of Fame inductee, Lenny Muddle on Bike 10, for helping to bring the first Postie Bike Dash to life in 2014 and ensuring its continuing success over the past decade.

Congratulations to Matt Russell on Bike 94, who won the Spirit of the Dash by entertaining kids at every stop with his bike chalkboard. A huge thank you to our highest fundraisers, the Tamex Postie Dogs, as well as Sam Handley on Bike 110 who was our highest fundraising individual.

Variety Mini Postie Bike Dash

In 2024, we held our Variety Mini Postie Bike Dash through the Upper Hunter which welcomed four new Dashers and 16 returning Dashers to our community. Thank you to Scone RSL for sponsoring the event and ensuring our entrants were well looked after during pre-event preparations.









The 2024 Variety 4WD Adventure Sky High soared to epic heights with 72 Adventurers taking the journey through some of Australia's most breathtaking landscapes and raising over \$317,000 to support kids in need.


The 38 returning Adventurers and 34 new Adventurers embarked from the picturesque beaches of Merimbula before driving through the East Gippsland region and the Victorian High Country, with a special stop at Craig's Hut.

While on the road, we stopped at East Gippsland Specialist School, Buchan Primary School, Jamieson Primary School and Licola Wilderness Village who received Variety We Join Motoring Grants for sporting equipment, including basketball hoops and specialist trikes.

Michael Mitchell, a PE Teacher at East Gippsland Specialist School said, "The balance bikes have already helped some students progress from riding tricycles to two wheelers in just a few weeks." Michael explained how granting bike education lessons has contributed to students being more road aware, improving safety throughout their community.

Congratulations to Car 61, driven by Don and Trish Ekert, for winning the coveted Spirit of the Adventure award. A big thank





you to Sharon White and Christine Scott from Car 24 for being our highest fundraisers on the event.

Lastly, an enormous congratulations to Rachel O'Sullivan and Marty Perry for your surprise engagement at the final arch! We look forward to celebrating the anniversary of your engagement on the Variety 4WD Adventure every year.





2024 marked the fifth annual Variety Adventure Ride, seeing 20 riders, including 11 new Riders, raise over \$130,600 to support kids who are sick, experiencing disadvantage or living with disability.

Our passionate Riders travelled through the Victorian High Country, stopping at the iconic Craig's Hut and riding over MacKillops Bridge, before returning through Merimbula and back to Lake Jindabyne.


Along the route we stopped to deliver grants to three communities in need, totalling over \$17,000. Porepunkah Primary School received a grant of \$4,374 to develop a woodworking program for students who are at risk of disengagement due to disability, anxiety or low levels of literacy. We granted \$6,054 to Mansfield Junior Football Club for sporting equipment to help maintain continued community engagement. The last grant was to Delegate Public School, where we funded grandstands worth \$6,670 that will provide seating for students, families and other community members. These were put to good use when Riders and students played a fun game of handball!

Congratulations to Darren King on Bike 17 for winning the Spirit of the Ride award, and to Nick Johnson on Bike 4 for being championed as the highest individual fundraiser.

The 2024 Variety NSW Bash was an unforgettable seven-day journey that welcomed 84 first-time Bashers in 16 new cars, alongside 175 returning Bashers in 80 cars, together raising over \$1.2 million for kids in need.

With a remote start in Gunnedah, our Bashers crossed the New South Wales and Queensland border to spend three days exploring Southern Queensland. Over the 2,340 kilometre drive, we granted more than \$60,000 worth of equipment and resources to eleven regional schools and one community group along the route. These grants ranged from marquees and readers to workbooks and musical instruments, all promoting inclusion and engagement in schools for all students - regardless of their ability or background.

The 2024 Variety NSW Bash ended with an unforgettable Variety Family Fun Day at the Newcastle Foreshore, where families celebrated the arrival of our colourful and wonderful characters in their Bash Cars. The event included rides, a petting zoo and amazing performances. Thank you to our Variety Family Fun Day presenting partner, Orica, for helping make the event possible.

OV Kevin Leahy OAM achieved an enormous feat on the 2024 Variety NSW Bash, celebrating his hundredth Variety motoring event! Thank you Kevin, for all the hard work that you have put in over your years of involvement at Variety.

The 2024 Variety B to B Bash was one for the history books, celebrating the 40th anniversary of this iconic event. Driving along the original 1985 Basher's tracks, 230 Bashers drove from Bash's Billabong in Dubbo to Bombira, raising an epic \$1.4 million for children who are sick, experiencing disadvantage or living with disability.

Over the 6,078 kilometre route, we stopped at 11 schools and granted more than \$74,000 for vital equipment and resources in regional communities. One of our memorable stops was at Toomelah Public School, a small school of 45 students positioned in the heart of the Aboriginal community of Toomelah along the Macintyre River. Here we delivered a huge surprise, where every student at the school was given their very own bike, along with a custom-made name plate and a helmet. This grant allows for every student at Toomelah Public School to participate on their own terms, providing equal opportunity and access to their community.

The 2024 Variety B to B Bash route wouldn't have been complete without a special guest appearance from Bash legend, Dick Smith, in Birdsville, one of the original 1985 Bash stops. Thanks Dick, for stopping by to show your continuing support.


