The Variety B to B Bash is an iconic Australian tradition, and in 2025 we are taking you on an unforgettable journey. This 11-day, 3,600km trek will wind through the stunning landscapes of southern New South Wales and climb the mountainous trails of Victoria, culminating in a historic 'National Bash' event in Adelaide before traversing to Blacktown through remote, yet remarkable, small towns.



2025 marks Variety's 50th Anniversary in Australia! To celebrate, we're holding the first Variety National Bash in 10 years, where 650 Bash cars from every Variety Bash route, from Western Australia to Queensland, will meet in Adelaide to celebrate this collective milestone.

Where We're Going

Our adventure begins in charming Bomaderry in the heart of the Shoalhaven, where we'll set off on an epic road trip that will take us across some of the most stunning landscapes in the country to Adelaide and back.

Our journey west from Bomaderry takes us up towards Goulburn, a historic town with a rich colonial heritage. From there, we'll head across to Yass and down into the Riverina region, exploring charming rural towns and breathtaking scenery along the way.

Our journey will continue through the tiny town of Nangus, before crossing the Murray River down towards Albury and into Victoria. Here, we'll visit the historic gold rush country of Bendigo and Horsham as we traverse the incredible beauty, and driving, that Grampians National Park has to offer.

Our journey continues to Adelaide, where we'll have the chance to explore the fascinating National Motor Museum. After that, it's time to party! Join us at the National Bash Party for a night of celebration.

The next day, we'll have a well-deserved rest to explore Adelaide at our own pace. From there, we'll rejoin the Murray River, travelling through the charming towns of Renmark and Swan Hill before reaching the Murrumbidgee River region.

Our final leg of the journey will take us through Wagga Wagga and Mittagong, culminating in a grand finale at Blacktown with a memorable Final Night Dinner.



A Truly Australian Experience

Throughout our adventure, we'll discover the hidden gems of Australia's outback. From exploring remote towns to admiring incredible silo art, this is your chance to experience the true spirit of this amazing country. Connect with like-minded travellers, create lasting memories and immerse yourself in the beauty of Australia.
